STATE TESTING - INTERIM ASSESSMENT

 $3^{rd} - 5^{th}$ grade students will be participating in a short interim assessment within the state testing protocol on their school one to one devices in class sometime during the day on January 25 & 26. These are very short, practice assessments for students to become more comfortable navigating the software and in preparation for the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) to be formally conducted in May. We will hold another interim assessment session in the coming months, again as practice and to increase student familiarity.
