

# ROCK Your Goals

Goals are set by grade-level, individualized, and school-wide. We incorporate these goals into an incentive program for students to earn field trips and other incentives earned by reaching these goals.

---

**Accelerated Reader (AR):** Generally for 2nd–5th grade students, although many 1st grade students are ready for this program by mid-year. The student goals are set by individual readiness level. Students read books within a specific and assigned level, followed by a computerized test on the computer at school.

**Accelerated Math (AM):** 2nd–5th grade students start from the beginning of the year, while Kindergarten and 1st grade students begin this program at teacher discretion and based on student readiness. Goals are set by grade-level and a student progresses through the program at his/her own rate with assistance from school staff. Computerized and printed work for student to complete, then transfer to scan sheet to process at school.

**Math Facts in a Flash (MFF):** 1st–5th grade students participate. Students may practice from our website link while at home, but must conduct actual testing on school computers to register as passage for goals. This is a timed program for each level of math facts mastered.

Kindergarten and 1st grade students are in grade-level assigned mastery goals for reading and math until such time as they may be ready to proceed with AR, AM, and MFF.

**Perfect attendance:** Staff and Team ROCK visits to each classroom to recognize students who have been in school each day that month.

---

**Behavior and Social Excellence:** Students may earn yellow tickets from any staff member on campus for exhibiting a positive behavior or for demonstrating a social skill that promotes kindness, safety, or respect for self, others, or the school. Each yellow ticket then becomes not only a method of communication home, but also a ticket for an opportunity to be drawn from the classroom yellow ticket bucket for monthly events that will take place on campus for yellow ticket honorees.
